USE OF CHANGING ROOMS

The toilets and changing facilities for Alrewas Tennis Club (ATC) are situated at one end of the Cricket Club. The changing rooms are also used by other clubs who also have identified key-holders. Currently these include the Cricket Club and Alrewas Colts Football Club. Alrewas Cricket Club is responsible for maintaining the complete list of all key-holders.

There is limited access to changing rooms and toilets at Alrewas Tennis Club because a key holder needs to be present in order to open the doors unless the cricket pavilion is open. Current key holders for ATC are the committee, coaching staff and the Men's and Women's Teams Captains.

Members wishing to play should attend in suitable sports gear and ready to play wherever possible.

The changing rooms should not be used by children unless a parent/carer or a person nominated in writing by the parent is present.

Where a child requires the toilet, a key-holder will open the door and wait outside the toilets unless the child asks for help. If a child asks for help, the key-holder will inform the parent/carer that this has happened.

Coaches and Team Captains must make visitors and travelling teams aware of limitations regarding toilet and changing facilities.

The toilet and changing facilities should not be left unlocked for the duration of a match and must be secured when no one is inside the building.
